The faxed or e-mailed document, which must bear a facsimile of the required signature, will be accepted as an original document. The authorized faxed or e-mailed filing is considered filed when date stamped by the clerk's office.

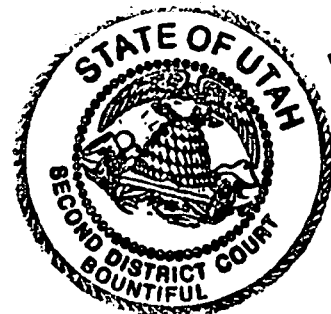
