



appoint one for you.)

- the right to nominate a guardian and/or conservator of your choice;
- the right to limit the guardian's and conservator's authority to that needed for protection;
- the right to receive written reasons for the appointments;
- the right to demand that the hearing be open or closed to the public;
- the right to present evidence;
- the right to ask questions of witnesses;
- the right to be examined by a court-appointed physician;
- the right to be interviewed by a court-appointed visitor and to ask that the visitor interview the proposed guardian/conservator;
- the right to ask that the visitor visit your current home and proposed home; and
- the right to trial by jury.

You and any person interested in your welfare also have the right to ask the court for a hearing to end the guardian/conservator, to appoint a different guardian or conservator, or to change the guardian's or conservator's authority.

If a guardian/conservator is appointed, the guardian/conservator will make decisions in the areas in which the court decides you need protection. The guardian/conservator may have the authority to make decisions about:

- where you live;
- your healthcare, including end of life choices;
- your finances, like investing or spending your money;
- your business and property.

In addition, if the court finds that you are incapacitated, you may no longer be able to:

- drive a car;
- make a will;
- marry or divorce;
- vote; or
- give testimony in legal proceeding.

**Interpretation.** If you do not speak or understand English, contact a judicial services representative at least 3 days before the hearing, and an interpreter will be provided.
