Re: 2009 Poverty Income Guidelines-**EXTENDED FOR 2010 USE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE**

For the appointment of counsel in criminal cases, Utah Code Section 77-32-202(3)(a) defines indigency as “an income level at or below 150% of the United States poverty level as defined by the most recently revised poverty income guidelines published by the United States Department of Health and Human Services.” The following table has been generated from the HHS poverty guidelines issued January 23, 2009. **The Department of Health and Human Services has issued an extension of the 2009 Poverty Guidelines until further notice. Please continue to use this table for 2010 until updated poverty guidelines are published.**
