

1 **Rule 14-710. Composition-Administration of the Bar Examination.**

2 (a) ~~Student-Bar Examination. The student-Bar Examination shall include a written~~
3 ~~component and the MBE. The written component of the examination may consist of up~~
4 ~~to eight essay questions and two MPT questions. One essay question shall relate to~~
5 ~~legal ethics. Essay questions may be taken from the MEE and/or state prepared essay~~
6 ~~questions. Students and student attorney applicants are required to take the student Bar~~
7 ~~Examination~~consists of the UBE. To qualify as the UBE, all components of the Bar
8 Examination must be taken in the same examination administration and given according
9 to the standards established by the NCBE.

10 (b) Exam schedule. The Bar Examination is administered on the last consecutive
11 Tuesday and Wednesday in February and July. The MEE and MPT are administered on
12 Tuesday and the MBE is administered on Wednesday. ~~Attorney Bar Examination. The~~
13 ~~attorney Bar Examination shall consist of the written component of the student Bar~~
14 ~~Examination. Attorney applicants who meet the requirements set forth in Rule 14-704~~
15 ~~are eligible to sit for the attorney Bar Examination.~~

16 (c) MBE score transferability. The Bar will accept MBE scores transferred from
17 another jurisdiction only if the MBE is taken concurrent with the Written Component in
18 Utah. To transfer a MBE score, an Applicant must send a written transfer request, along
19 with the prescribed fee, to the NCBE.
