2 (a) MPRE requirements. In ~~addition to~~conjunction with the requirements of Rule 14-
3 716(e), an Applicant must receive a passing score on the MPRE prior to admission to
4 the Bar. ~~The passing score must be achieved within two years of the date of the Bar~~
5 ~~Examination.~~ A scaled score of 86 is ~~considered~~ passing. ~~A scaled score of 80 will be~~
6 ~~considered passing for Bar Examinations taken on or before July 2004.~~ It is the
7 Applicant's responsibility to ensure that ~~his or her~~a passing MPRE score is reported to
8 the Bar.

9 (b) Administration of the MPRE. The MPRE is administered by the NCBE. To take
10 the MPRE, an Applicant must file an application with and pay the prescribed fee to the
