

1 **Rule 14-714. Unsuccessful Applicants: disclosure and right of inspection.**

2 (a) Inspection of the Written Component. The Written Component of the Bar
3 Examination shall be retained for no fewer than six months after the date that
4 examination's results have been announced. An unsuccessful Applicant shall be
5 entitled to a reasonable inspection of:

6 ~~(a)(1) the essay and MPT questions;~~

7 ~~(a)(2) the Applicant's answers to the essay-MEE and MPT questions of the~~
8 examination;

9 ~~(a)(3) the model answer for each question; and~~

10 ~~(a)(4) an explanation of the grading process.~~ (b) The MEE and MPT questions and
11 analyses are available from the NCBE.

12 ~~(c)~~ Privileged Information is not subject to disclosure.

13 ~~(d)~~ Inspection of MBE. This rule does not permit an Applicant to inspect ~~the~~ MBE
14 questions or her or his answers which is administered nationally. Neither copies of the
15 MBE questions nor answers are retained by the Bar.
