

1 **Rule 14-717. Readmission after resignation or disbarment of Utah attorneys.**

2 (a) Readmission after resignation without discipline pending. Readmission
3 subsequent to the resignation without discipline pending of a member of the Bar
4 requires a new application, payment of fees, and a character and fitness investigation.
5 An [A](#)applicant is not required to retake the Bar Examination but must fully comply with
6 the requirements of Rule 14-716.

7 (b) Readmission of [D](#)isbarred [A](#)attorneys. An [A](#)applicant for readmission to the Bar
8 under these circumstances shall satisfy all requirements of this article, including Rules
9 14-703, 14-707(c), 14-708(g) and 14-716, and shall satisfy all other requirements
10 imposed by Rule 14-525, the OPC, and Utah courts. A report and recommendation shall
11 be filed by the Character and Fitness Committee in the district court in which the
12 [A](#)applicant has filed his or her petition for readmission. The district court must approve
13 the [A](#)applicant's petition for readmission under Rule 14-525 before an [A](#)applicant can be
14 admitted and licensed under Rule 14-716 to practice law.
