

Regulation 3-104

(1) Active Emeritus members of the Bar shall comply with the standard continuing legal education requirements by participation in 12 hours of continuing legal education.

(2) In the alternative, Active Emeritus members of the Bar may work in conjunction with another active licensed member of the Bar in lieu of complying with the standard 12 hours of continuing legal education.

(3) Active Emeritus members of the Bar who elect to work in conjunction with another active licensed member of the Bar in lieu of continuing legal education, shall file with the Board by January 31, following the year for which the report is due, a signed statement from the member of the Bar verifying that he/she has complied with the requirements of this regulation.

(4) Active Emeritus is a lawyer who has been a member of the Bar for 50 years or who is 75 years of age as of July 1 of the current year and who qualifies for Emeritus Status.
