IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that operation of Rule 11(b)(1)(C) of the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure which requires the record on appeal to be put in chronological order; beginning with the earliest-filed document on top and the last-filed document on the bottom, is suspended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rule 11(b)(1)(C) of the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure is amended to state as follows:

(B)(1)(C) all original papers in chronological order;

This amendment is effective as of April 1, 2005, under the expedited rulemaking provisions of Rule 11-101(6)(F) of the Supreme Court Rules of Professional Practice.
