

1 Rule 64C. Writ of attachment.

2 (a) Availability. A writ of attachment is available to seize property in the possession
3 or under the control of the defendant.

4 (b) Grounds. In addition to the grounds required in Rule 64A, the grounds for a writ
5 of attachment require all of the following:

6 (b)(1) that the defendant is indebted to the plaintiff;

7 (b)(2)(i) that the action is upon a contract or is against a defendant who is not a
8 resident of this state or is against a foreign corporation not qualified to do business in
9 this state; or

10 (b)(2)(ii) the writ is authorized by statute; and

11 (b)(3) that payment of the claim has not been secured by a lien upon property in this
12 state.
