

1 Rule 14-1102. Purpose and composition of the committee.

2 (a) The purpose of the Committee is to resolve fee disputes between attorneys and  
3 their clients by means of arbitration, mediation or other alternative dispute resolution  
4 mechanisms.

5 (b) The Committee shall consist of such number of members as may be determined  
6 annually by the president of the Bar. The president of the Bar shall designate one of the  
7 members of the Committee as the chair. At the discretion of the president, a vice chair  
8 and/or secretary may be appointed from the members of the Committee.

9 (c) Participation in the fee arbitration process is non-mandatory. If all the necessary  
10 parties elect in writing to arbitrate, however, the decision is binding.

11 (d). After all parties have agreed in writing to be bound by an arbitration decision, a  
12 party may not withdraw from that agreement unless all parties agree to the withdrawal in  
13 writing.
