

1 Rule 6-402. Records in domestic relations cases.

2 Intent

3 To define the records required for motions for temporary relief, alimony, child
4 support, and child custody.

5 Applicability

6 This rule applies in the District Court.

7 Statement of the Rule

8 All motions for temporary relief in domestic relations cases must include all records,
9 forms, information and affidavits necessary to support the party's position. Attachments
10 to motions and responses regarding alimony shall include income verification and a
11 financial declaration. Attachments to motions and responses regarding child support
12 and child custody shall include income verification and a financial declaration and a
13 child support worksheet. A financial declaration shall be filed under oath or affirmation
14 or declaration under criminal penalty.
