

1 **Rule 3-114. Judicial outreach.**

2 Intent:

3 To foster a greater role for judges in service to the community.

4 To provide leadership and resources for outreach.

5 To improve public trust and confidence in the judiciary.

6 Applicability:

7 This rule shall apply to all justices and judges.

8 Statement of the Rule:

9 (1) The Committee on Judicial Outreach shall:

10 (1)(A) create and promote model outreach programs;

11 (1)(B) promote local outreach programs;

12 (1)(C) develop policies and rules that encourage judicial participation in outreach
13 programs;

14 (1)(D) work with educators to incorporate civic education into school curriculums;

15 (1)(E) work with the Utah State Bar to develop joint outreach programs; and

16 (1)(F) communicate judicial outreach efforts.

17 (2) Consistent with the Code of Judicial Conduct and to increase public
18 understanding of and involvement with the administration of justice, the judiciary is
19 encouraged to:

20 ~~(2)(A) identify and address issues of access to justice within the court system~~
21 ~~including any physical, language, or economic barriers that impede the fair~~
22 ~~administration of justice;~~

23 ~~(2)(B)~~ (2)(A) educate civic, educational, business, charitable, media and other
24 groups about the court system and judicial process; and

25 ~~(2)(C)~~ (2)(B) take an active part in the community where the participation of the
26 judiciary will serve to increase public understanding and promote public confidence in
27 the integrity of the court system.
