

1 **Rule 14-702. Board - general powers.**

2 (a) Admission to the Bar. The Board shall recommend and certify to the Supreme
3 Court for admission to the Bar persons who possess the necessary qualifications of
4 learning, ability and character which are a prerequisite to the privilege of engaging in the
5 ~~P~~practice of ~~L~~law, and who fulfill the requirements for admission to the Bar as provided
6 by this article.

7 (b) Subpoena power. The ~~E~~executive ~~D~~director, the ~~G~~general ~~C~~counsel and the
8 ~~D~~deputy ~~G~~general ~~C~~counsel shall have power to issue subpoenas for the attendance of
9 witnesses or for the production of documentary evidence before the Board or before
10 anyone authorized to act on its behalf.

11 (c) Administration of oaths. Members of the Board, the ~~E~~executive ~~D~~director and
12 their designees shall have power to administer oaths in furtherance of this article.

13 (d) Taking of testimony. Members of the Board, the ~~E~~executive ~~D~~director and their
14 designees shall have the power to take testimony in furtherance of this article.

15 (e) Regulations. The Board is empowered to appoint committees or persons who
16 may adopt and enforce reasonable regulations and policies ~~and to appoint committees~~
17 ~~or persons~~ in furtherance of this article.

18 (f) Waiver of rules. Neither the Bar nor its representatives has authority to waive any
19 rule. Waiver of any rule may only be obtained by petitioning the Supreme Court.
