

1 **Rule 20. Discovery generally.**

2 (a) Discovery involving adjudications of delinquency, offenses by adults
3 against minors, and proceedings brought pursuant to Section 78A-6-702 and
4 Section 78A-6-703 shall be conducted in accordance with Utah R. Cr. P. 16,
5 except where limited by these rules, the Code of Judicial Administration, or and
6 the Juvenile Court Act.

7 (b) In substantiation cases, no later than thirty days prior to trial, parties shall
8 provide to each other information necessary to support its claims or defenses
9 unless otherwise ordered by the court.

10 (c) Rule 26.1 of the Rules of Civil Procedure does not apply in any juvenile
11 proceedings unless there is a showing of good cause and it is ordered by the
12 court.

13 (d)(e) In all other cases, discovery shall be conducted pursuant to these rules
14 unless modified by a showing of good cause and by order of the court.
