2        ~~Notwithstanding the provisions of Rules 64B, 64C and 64D requiring a bond or undertaking~~  
3 ~~to be filed by a party as a condition for obtaining any relief under the provisions of said rules, the~~  
4 ~~court in which the action is pending may, after hearing of a motion on such notice to the~~  
5 ~~opposing party as the court shall require, reduce or increase the amount of such bond or~~  
6 ~~undertaking, or relieve the moving party from the necessity of filing any bond or undertaking~~  
7 ~~which would otherwise be required to be filed if the court determines that the interests of justice~~  
8 ~~would be best served thereby.~~

9        ~~In no event, however, shall such action by the court relieve the party obtaining the same from~~  
10 ~~any liability which may be incurred in consequence of the action taken by him, for which he~~  
11 ~~shall be and continue to be liable to any other person or party as fully and completely as if a bond~~  
12 ~~or undertaking were in fact given.~~
