

1 **Rule 29B. Hearings with remote conferencing from a different location.**

2 Pursuant to rule 4-106 of the Utah Code of Judicial Administration:

3 (a) In any delinquency proceeding or proceeding under Section 78A-6-702 or
4 Section 78A-6-703 the court may conduct the following hearings with the minor or the
5 minor's parent, guardian or custodian attending by ~~contemporaneous transmission~~
6 remote conferencing from a different location:

7 (a)(1) contempt

8 (a)(2) detention;

9 (a)(3) motion;

10 (a)(4) review; and

11 (a)(5) warrant.

12 (b) Except as provided in Paragraph (a), upon motion of ~~a party~~ and for good cause
13 shown, the court may permit a party or a minor's parent, guardian, or custodian to
14 attend any delinquency hearing or hearing under Section 78A-6-702 or Section 78A-6-
15 703 by remote conferencing from a different location.

16 (c) In compelling circumstances and with appropriate safeguards, the court may
17 permit testimony in open court by ~~contemporaneous transmission~~-remote conferencing
18 from a different location if the party not calling the witness waives confrontation of the
19 witness in person.

20 (d) If the court permits remote conferencing, the court may require a party to make
21 the arrangements for the remote conferencing.
