

1 **Rule 14-710. Administration of the Bar Examination.**

2 (a) Bar Examination. The Bar Examination consists of the UBE. ~~To qualify as the UBE,~~
3 ~~a~~All components of the Bar Examination must be taken in the same examination
4 administration and given according to the standards established by the NCBE.

5 (b) Exam ~~schedule~~components. The Bar Examination ~~components are~~ administered on
6 ~~the last consecutive Tuesday and Wednesday in February and July. The MEE and MPT~~
7 ~~are administered on Tuesday and the MBE is administered on Wednesday~~ the MEE,
8 MPT, and MBE.

9 (c) ~~MBE score transferability. The Bar will accept MBE scores transferred from another~~
10 ~~jurisdiction only if the MBE is taken concurrent with the Written Component in Utah. To~~
11 ~~transfer a MBE score, an Applicant must send a written transfer request, along with the~~
12 ~~prescribed fee, to the NCBE.~~(c) The Bar Examination is administered only for the
13 purpose of admission to the Bar.
