Dear Committee Members:

A special meeting of the Committee will be held on Wednesday, December 1, 1993, beginning at 4:00 p.m. As usual, the meeting will convene in the Council Room, Administrative Office of the Court, 230 South 500 East, Salt Lake City, Utah. Please be prompt so that we can begin and end on time.

At our meeting on December 1, we will consider the following:

1. We will again consider proposed changes to Rule 30(f). I have enclosed a revised draft of that rule, which attempts to incorporate the suggestions that we discussed in October. In addition, I am enclosing a letter from committee member Jim Soper who has some additional ideas for related changes to Rule 30(e) and 30(d). We should probably consider all of these changes together at our December meeting.

2. We will again consider proposed Rule 72 on writs of restitution. Please find enclosed a substantially revised redraft of that rule, which I prepared in consultation with our subcommittee on Rule 72. Terry McIntosh, Bruce Plenk and James Deans are in the process of preparing forms which may be sent to you before our meeting. In addition, I have enclosed a copy of a letter from Lisa Watts Baskin; her request is self-explanatory

3. We will ask for a report from our subcommittee on rule 64D relating to the continuing garnishments project. I am hopeful that we will have some language for you to look at by the time of our meeting.

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4. We will again consider the problem of forms for the rest of the rules of civil procedure. Shortly after our last meeting, Tom Karrenberg sent me a memorandum in which he outlined the forms that require revision. I enclose his memorandum dated October 26, 1993. Now that the membership of our committee is finalized, we can undertake the project of revising the forms.

5. Finally, we will discuss Rule 63(b), disqualification of judges. Colin Winchester has had a member of his staff conduct research on the experience of other states. If that research is now completed, we will ask for a report.

I look forward to seeing all of you on December 1.
