

1 | **Rule 4A. Defendant's removal to district court.**
2

3 | (a) To exercise the right to a jury trial, a defendant shall:
4

5 | (a)(1) Within 15 days of being served with the affidavit, file a notice of removal in the district
6 court;
7

8 | (a)(2) pay the appropriate filing fee, unless waived by the district court; and
9

10 | (a)(3) file a copy of the notice of removal in the small claims court, with the number of the
11 district court case, and proof of service.
12

13 | (b) Upon filing the notice of removal, the clerk of the justice court shall close its case and the
14 matter shall continue in district court under the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure.
15

16 | (c) If a case is not removed to district court pursuant to this rule, the right to a jury trial in the first
17 instance is waived and the matter, including any appeal, shall proceed according to these rules.
