

**Rule 15-702. Board - general powers.**

1 (a) LPP Licensure. The Board shall recommend and certify to the Supreme Court for  
2 licensure as an LPP persons who possess the necessary qualifications of learning, ability and  
3 character which are a prerequisite to the privilege of licensure as an LPP, and who fulfill the  
4 requirements for licensure as provided by this article.

5 (b) Subpoena power. The Executive Director and the General Counsel shall have power to  
6 issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses or for the production of documentary evidence  
7 before the Board or before anyone authorized to act on its behalf.

8 (c) Administration of oaths. Members of the Board, the Executive Director and their  
9 designees shall have power to administer oaths in furtherance of this article.

10 (d) Taking of testimony. Members of the Board, the Executive Director and their designees  
11 shall have the power to take testimony in furtherance of this article.

12 (e) Regulations. The Board is empowered to appoint committees or persons who may adopt  
13 and enforce reasonable regulations and policies in furtherance of this article.

14 (f) Waiver of rules. Neither the Bar nor its representatives has authority to waive any rule.  
15 Waiver of any rule may only be obtained by petitioning the Supreme Court.
