

**Rule 7.4. Communication of Fields of Practice.**

1        (a) A licensed paralegal practitioner must communicate the fact that the licensed paralegal  
2 practitioner practices only in particular fields of law.

6        [1] Paragraph (a) of this Rule permits a licensed paralegal practitioner to indicate areas of  
7 practice in communications about the licensed paralegal practitioner's services. If a licensed  
8 paralegal practitioner practices only in certain fields or will not accept matters except in a  
9 specified field or fields, the licensed paralegal practitioner is required to so indicate. A licensed  
10 paralegal practitioner is generally permitted to state that the licensed paralegal practitioner is a  
11 "specialist," practices a "specialty" or "specializes in" particular fields, but such communications  
12 are subject to the "false and misleading" standard applied in Rule 7.1 to communications  
13 concerning a licensed paralegal practitioner's services.
