

1 **Rule 14-413. [~~MGLE credit~~] CLE Accreditation for qualified audio and video**  
2 **presentations, webcasts, computer interactive telephonic programs, writing,**  
3 **lecturing, teaching, public service, and live attendance.**

4 (a) Self-Study CLE Credit will be allowed for [~~self-study with Board~~] Accredited audio  
5 and video presentations, webcasts or computer interactive telephonic programs, writing,  
6 lecturing, teaching, and [~~public service and~~] service in accordance with the following.

7 (a)(1) One hour of [~~self-study~~] Self-Study CLE credit will be allowed for viewing and/or  
8 listening to 60 minutes of audio or video presentations, webcasts, or computer  
9 interactive telephonic programs in accordance with Rule 14-408(a).

10 (a)(2) [~~No more than 12 hours of credit may be obtained through self-study with audio or~~  
11 ~~video presentations, webcasts or computer interactive telephonic programs.~~] Upon  
12 application to the Board, the Board may grant a waiver, permitting a lawyer or paralegal  
13 practitioner on active status to obtain all required hours of credit through [~~self-study~~]  
14 Self-Study CLE, if the lawyer or paralegal practitioner:

15 (a)(2)(A) does not reside in Utah; and

16 (a)(2)(B) is engaged in full-time volunteer work for a religious or charitable organization.

17 (b) [~~Credit will be~~] Self-Study CLE is allowed for writing and publishing an article in a  
18 legal periodical in accordance with the following.

19 (b)(1) To be eligible for any credit, an article must: (b)(1)(A) be written to address a lawyer  
20 audience; (b)(1)(B) be at least 3,000 words in length;

21 (b)(1)(C) be published by a recognized publisher of legal material; and (b)(1)(D) not be

22 used in conjunction with a seminar.

23 (b)(2) Three Self-Study credit hours will be allowed for each 3,000 words in the article.

24 An application for Accreditation of the article must be submitted at least ~~[60]~~ 30 days

25 prior to reporting the ~~[activity]~~ article for credit. Two or more authors may share credit

26 obtained pursuant to this paragraph in proportion to their contribution to the article. ~~[No~~

27 ~~more than 12 hours of credit may be obtained through writing and publishing an article or~~

28 ~~articles.]~~

29 (c) ~~[Credit will be]~~ Self-Study credit is allowed for lecturing in an Accredited CLE

30 program, part-time teaching by a lawyer or paralegal practitioner in an approved law

31 school, or delivering a paper or speech on a professional subject at a meeting primarily

32 attended by lawyers, paralegal practitioners legal assistants, or law students in

33 accordance with the following.

34 (c)(1) Lecturers in an Accredited CLE program and part-time teachers may receive

35 three ~~[self-study]~~ hours of Self-Study credit for each hour spent in lecturing or teaching

36 as provided in Rule 14-409(a)(1); ~~however, no lecturing or teaching credit is available~~

37 ~~for]~~, including participation in panel discussions.

38 (c)(2) Lecturers in a community outreach capacity, as described in Rule 14- 409(a)(2),

39 may receive one hour of ~~[self-study]~~ Self-Study credit for each hour spent in lecturing or

40 teaching provided such CLE credit does not exceed ~~[nine (9)]~~ four hours for a ~~[reporting~~

41 ~~period]~~ Compliance Cycle for a lawyer or two hours for a Compliance Cycle for a

42 paralegal practitioner.

43 ~~[(c)(3) No more than 12 hours of self-study credit may be obtained through lecturing,~~

44 ~~community outreach lecturing, part-time teaching and public service, under Rules 14-~~

45 409(a)(1) or (2).]

46 [~~(d) Credit will be allowed for lecturing and teaching by full-time law school faculty~~  
47 ~~members in accordance with the following.~~]

48 (d)[~~(1)~~] Full-time law school faculty members may receive Self-Study CLE credit for  
49 lecturing and teaching, including participating as a presenter in a panel discussion, but  
50 only for lecturing and teaching Accredited CLE courses.

51 [~~(d)(2) No lecturing or teaching credit is available for participation in panel discussions.~~]

52 [~~(d)(3) No more than 12 hours of credit may be obtained through lecturing and teaching~~  
53 ~~by full-time law school faculty members.~~]

54 [~~(e) Credit will be allowed for attendance at an accredited CLE program in accordance~~  
55 ~~with the following.~~]

56 (e)(1) Credit is allowed for [~~attendance at an accredited~~] Live CLE [~~program~~] in  
57 accordance with Rule 14-408(a).

58 (e)(2) A lawyer must obtain a minimum of [~~12~~] six Accredited CLE hours, with no  
59 maximum restriction, [~~must be obtained~~] through [~~attendance at live in-person~~] Live CLE  
60 [~~programs~~].

61 (e)(3) A paralegal practitioner must obtain a minimum of three Accredited CLE hours,  
62 with no maximum restriction, through Live CLE.

63 (f) The total of all hours allowable under paragraphs (a), (b), (c), and (d) of this rule may  
64 not exceed [~~12~~] six hours during a [~~reporting period~~] Compliance Cycle for a lawyer, nor  
65 three hours during a Compliance Cycle for a paralegal practitioner.
