Effective July 19, 2018

Pursuant to recent amendments to UCA 78A-6-117, most notably those requiring the juvenile probation department to provide all moderate and high risk minors under court jurisdiction with case planning and other evidence based services, including those whose referrals are resolved through nonjudicial adjustment, it is hereby ordered that the probation department is authorized to make juvenile court social and/or legal records accessible to public or private individuals or agencies providing services to the subject of the record or to the subject's family, including services provided pursuant to a nonjudicial adjustment, if the probation officer determines that such access is necessary to provide effective services.
