**ORDER EXTENDING THE SUSPENSION OF IN-PERSON ORAL  
ARGUMENTS AND MEETINGS THROUGH MARCH 31, 2021**

In consideration of the continuing public health threat posed by COVID-19 and in light of a record increase in COVID-19 cases in Utah and predictions that we will continue to see increasing COVID-19 cases through this winter and spring, the Utah Supreme Court and Utah Court of Appeals hereby extend the July 29, 2020 order that all oral arguments and appellate court committee meetings be conducted remotely through March 31, 2021. We will continue monitoring the crisis on a weekly basis and may overturn or extend this Order based on the circumstances at that time.
