ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER FOR 6th DISTRICT COURT OPERATIONS DURING  
PANDEMIC  
IN-PERSON HEARINGS WHILE IN "YELLOW PHASE"  
May 10th, 2021


---

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

As all counties in the 6th Judicial District are now classified as being in the Yellow Phase of the Risk Response Plan as set forth in the Administrative Order originally signed by Chief Justice Durrant in March of 2020, all hearings currently scheduled will remain as set and will be held remotely. If the parties or attorneys on a case want the status of the hearing to be changed to in-person, they need to make that request in writing to the court, setting forth the reasons why it should be in-person. This order excludes criminal jury trials currently scheduled, or other hearings where the determination of the hearing set as in-person has already been made.

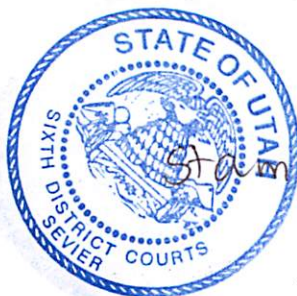
Hearings that may be considered for in-person status are evidentiary hearings, bench trials, or other meaningful hearings where the parties may be better served with the matter being in-person. Attorneys and court patrons should also be aware that the county could be moved again into the Red Phase, which means in-person hearings are only allowed under exigent circumstances.
