
**GENERAL ORDER REGARDING
TRUSTEE SALES AND SHERIFF SALES
AT MATHESON, WEST JORDAN,
SILVER SUMMIT, AND TOOELE
COURTHOUSES**

March 26, 2020

In accordance with the Administrative Order of the Utah Supreme Court and Utah Judicial Council dated March 21, 2020, Governor Gary R. Herbert's executive order declaring a state of emergency due to novel coronavirus disease 2019, and the Utah Department of Health's State Public Health Order regarding mass gatherings, the Third Judicial District Court (Salt Lake, Summit, and Tooele Counties) issues the following Order:

Effectively immediately, trustee sales and sheriff sales that are required to take place at the courthouse pursuant to Utah Code §§ 57-1-25 and 27 and Utah R. Civ. P. 69B, respectively, may not be held inside the courthouses. Such sales may be held outside on the courthouse grounds in a location designated by courthouse security or, if no location is designated, in a location that permits participants to maintain the recommended distance from each other and does not interfere with courthouse operations. So ordered.
