This matter is before the court upon a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, filed on November 27, 2020.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is granted as to the following issues:

- 1. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in concluding that Petitioner's trial counsel invited any error in the jury's access to a video-recorded police interview of him.
- 2. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in opining that Petitioner's trial counsel "did not perform deficiently by failing to ensure [that a video-recorded police interview] stayed out of jury deliberations given the lack of legal support for such a position."
- 3. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in concluding that Petitioner's trial counsel did not provide deficient performance in failing to object to a jury instruction.
