This matter is before the court upon a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, filed on April 23, 2019.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is granted as to the following issues:

1. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in its construction and application of the requirement in Section 76-5-106.5(2) of the Utah Code that a defendant "know or should know" that a course of conduct "would cause a reasonable person . . . to suffer emotional distress."
2. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in declining to address Petitioner's appellate argument that the evidence was insufficient to support a conclusion that he engaged in a course of conduct consisting of two or more acts pursuant to Section 76-5-106.5(1)(b).

A briefing schedule will be established hereafter. The parties shall comply with the briefing schedule upon its issuance. Requests for extension are disfavored, but may be granted with good cause.
