This matter is before the court upon a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, filed on September 4, 2019.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is granted as to the following issues:

1. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in affirming the district court's denial of Petitioner's motion to suppress evidence based on his Fourth Amendment argument that police officers lacked authority to use force, and used unreasonable force, to obtain a DNA sample pursuant to a warrant.

2. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in rejecting Petitioner's argument that police officers must have statutory authorization to use force to obtain a DNA sample pursuant to a warrant.

A briefing schedule will be established hereafter. The parties shall comply with the briefing schedule upon its issuance. Requests for extension are disfavored, but may be granted with good cause.
