The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is granted as to the following issue(s):

1. Whether the court of appeals erred in affirming the district courts denial of Cross-Petitioners Wittingham, LLC, et. al.s request for an award of attorney fees.

2. Whether the court of appeals erred in concluding Cross-Petitioners Wittingham, LLC, et. al., had failed to adequately brief their claims that a defaulting defendant, Mario Naujoks, should have been held jointly and severally liable.
