This matter is before the court upon a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, filed on April 22, 2020.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is granted as to the following issues:

- 1. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in concluding that Petitioners had failed to demonstrate that, as a matter of law, adequate warnings were provided to the operator of the boat in which Respondent was traveling when he was thrown from that boat and injured by it.
- 2. Whether the Court of Appeals erred in reversing the district court's conclusion that Petitioners had no duty to warn Respondent directly as a passenger.

In answering the second question, the Court requests that the parties address whether the duty recognized by the Court of Appeals is supported by the Restatement provisions on which it relied or on other authority, the proper nature and extent of a duty, if any, to warn a passenger, and how such a duty, if any, could be satisfied by an owner or operator.

A briefing schedule will be established hereafter. The parties shall comply with the briefing schedule upon its issuance. Requests for extension are disfavored, but may be granted with good cause.
