

## Deferred Traffic Prosecution Registration Steps

- 3. Click Next




4. Choose to either enter your court case number <u>OR</u> your citation number



## a. Case number tips


- i. Court Case Number: this is nine digits
- ii. **Location**: Use the dropdown to pick the court location where your citation was filed
- iii. Select Continue



## b. Citation number tips


- i. **Citation Number**: This can be a combination of numbers and letters
- ii. **Citation Date**: Enter the date your citation was issued

- iii. **Location**: Use the dropdown to pick the court location where your citation was filed
- iv. Select Continue








- 7. Enter your Utah driver's license number
  - a. Only those with a Utah driver's license can use Deferred Traffic Prosecution. But you can still view your case with a MyCase account without a license.
    - i. If you don't have a Utah driver's license, email <u>mycase@utcourts.gov</u> to get an account. Provide:
      - 1. Your case number
      - 2. Your court location
      - 3. A copy of your government-issued ID


- 8. Acknowledge the confidential information disclosure
- 9. Select Verify




a. If the information you entered doesn't find a match, try entering the information again. If that does not work, <u>contact the court</u> where your citation was filed.




10. Once your identity is verified, enter a valid email address. You must agree to receive notifications there.




- a. If the email address is already registered for a MyCase account you will see the message below. Log in using your password
  - i. Skip to number 18




- b. If you have already registered your case and email address, you will see this message, "The case party association already exists for the MyCase account"
  - Click on Login to MyCase here in the registration steps or go to <a href="https://mycase.utcourts.gov">https://mycase.utcourts.gov</a> to log in using your existing credentials



- 11. A verification code will be sent to the email address entered if it has not already been registered for a MyCase account

- 13. Select Continue




- 14. Enter a password

a. Select Continue to log into MyCase





- 17. If this is the first time you've logged into MyCase you will see two surveys
  - a. Complete both surveys and select Submit





18. You will see the Case Information screen for the case you registered and you will see a message letting you know <u>if</u> your case qualifies for Deferred Traffic Prosecution





- 19. If your case is eligible, click on Guided Interview to begin a series of questions to start your enrollment
  - a. An application and order will need to be submitted and payment is required for a fine and fee
- 20. When you have successfully enrolled in Deferred Traffic Prosecution, after completing the

application and making the payment(s) you will see a confirmation message on the Case Information screen when logged into MyCase
