Evans, his wife, hereinafter collectively referred to as "claimants", individually and in a representative capacity for and on behalf of all members and stockholders of Lehi Cattle Association, a Utah corporation, hereby object to the Proposed Determination of Water Rights In Utah Lake and Jordan River Drainage Area, Utah County Division, Cedar Valley Subdivision, and allege:

1. Claimants are all owners of real property, or interests therein, in the Cedar Valley Subdivision, Utah County

Division, of the Utah Lake and Jordan River Drainage Area and file this Objection pursuant to Section 73-4-11, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended.

2. Claimants, and their predecessors in title and interest, have beneficially used, continuously since before the year 1903, waters on their lands for the purpose of watering livestock.

3. By said Proposed Determination of Water Rights, the Utah State Engineer proposes that Lehi Cattle Association, a Utah corporation, be awarded the right to use and enjoy all of said waters to the exclusion of Claimants.

4. Said Lehi Cattle Association was incorporated on or about the 11th day of August, 1939; it owns no real property; and no water rights have been conveyed, assigned or otherwise transferred to said corporation by Claimants or by their predecessors in title and interest.

5. If the said Proposed Determination of Water Rights, insofar as it proposes to determine and adjudicate rights in favor of Lehi Cattle Association, is ratified and approved by the Court and if the Utah State Engineer is permitted to distribute waters pursuant thereto, Claimants will be deprived of the use of water rights which they have enjoyed continuously since before the year 1903.

WHEREFORE, Claimants pray that they be permitted to present evidence in support of their claims; that the Court adjudge and decree that the rights which the Utah State Engineer proposes to award to Lehi Cattle Association be awarded to Claimants as their interests appear; that the Utah State Engineer be restrained and enjoined from delivering waters to Lehi Cattle Association pursuant to said Proposed Determination; and that Claimants be awarded their costs herein incurred, together with

such other and further relief as to the Court may seem just and equitable in the premises.
