

Amended Version of Second District Court General Court Order 02-09

All persons entering district court facilities in the second district are subject to search for weapons, potential weapons, contraband, and any other object that may cause danger or injury to others, or that may disrupt the ordinary conduct of the business of the court. The sheriff, deputies, and other duly appointed peace officers are authorized to conduct searches, and are authorized to confiscate any such objects or to refuse entrance to the court to anyone possessing these items. Screening may be conducted by metal detection, x-ray screening, and similar devices. Law enforcement officers are also authorized to conduct pat-down and other searches that they determine to be necessary to ensure the security of the court. Any items seized by law enforcement shall be forfeited and destroyed or otherwise disposed of. Individuals who bring such objects to the court may be subject to contempt or arrest.
