CD DELIVERY METHOD

- Please email the audio to me. (\$10 per half-day of audio -- MP3 format.)
- Please mail the CD to me. (\$10 per CD, plus postage -- MP3 format.)
- I will pick up the CD at the courthouse. (\$10 per CD -- MP3 format.)

Payments must be made in advance, and may be set up on the court's website.

Efile the request using the document type "Request for Audio Recording". If your EFSP does not support this type of filing, or you are not an attorney, you may email the request to the appropriate courthouse. A judicial assistant will then contact you for payment information. Any CDs that are made and not picked up after 30 days will be destroyed, and payment forfeited. Audio requests may take up to 10 days to complete.
